Where you live – see map for HCC Division and SBC Ward boundaries

There are two councils providing different services where you live: Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) and Stevenage Borough Council (SBC).

Each HCC Division has one County Councillor. Elections are normally in May every 4 years with the last being in 2017. The next County elections will be in 2021 & 2025.

Each SBC Ward has 3 Borough Councillors. Elections are normally held for each seat in turn in May in each of the 3 years when there are not HCC elections: 2019, 2020, 2022.
